## Dear Parents,

Thank you all so much for your kind gifts, cards and kind words. We really were spoilt and appreciate your generosity.

BUDGET - before Christmas it was mentioned on the news that the government was in effect cutting back school \& education budgets as costs would carry on rising but the money given to schools would remain fixed. One of the reasons behind schools joining together was to minimise the effect of cutbacks. The federation between Kemble and Siddington, with some shared staffing costs, mean that we are in a good position for the immediate future and providing we keep numbers up, then we should be able to cope. We will however need to look to the future and joining other schools, to enable us to keep providing all we want to for our children and future generations. The governors continue with their investigations into Multi Academy Trusts (MATs) and joining groups of schools.

## SCIENCE EXPLORER DOME -

 We are pleased to tell you that we have booked a science 'explorer dome' to visit the school this term. Children from Year 1 to Year 6 will visit the dome (go inside!) for a science lesson! We hope all the children have fun and are inspired scien- tifically!

SCHOOL COUNCIL FUNDRAISER - the next school council fundraiser will be on February $10^{\text {th }}$ - money raised will be for playground development and equipment for the children - your support will be very gratefully received.

STACKPOLE RESIDENTIAL - Our Year 6 children will be off on their amazing residential the week of the $23^{\text {rd }}$ January. Please can all parents and children make sure they attend the meetings so that you are up to date with all the information you need - kit list etc!. The final meeting is on January 10th at 3.30 pm at Kemble. All payments should have been made by now if you have any outstanding payments please make sure that these are paid before the leave date - thank you and have fun!

PARENT / HEAD CHAT - I look forward to seeing everyone on $13^{\text {th }}$ January 9:30am at Kemble and 2:45-or 2:30 if you can at Siddington. I would like to discuss our behaviour policy to make sure parents understand the process and to get any further parental ideas and also thoughts on homework. If you can't make the meeting, please email the office to put forward any ideas or suggestions. Our policies are on the school websites for you to look at prior to the meeting.

ATTENDANCE \& ARRIVING ON TIME - Please try to bring your child to school on time as they often have early work to do and may practice French during register. Children prefer to arrive in time to see their friends in the playground rather than having to come into class while everyone is sat on the floor already. Please remember that all schools have a target of at least $95 \%$ attendance. $5 \%$ is allowed for 'normal' childhood illness. Schools or children who have less than $95 \%$ are investigated. Your help is very much appreciated!
DEVELOPMENT PROJECT - we are pleased to say that the old Chestnut Class (old ICT suite) has been re-structured to be the Breakfast Club, After School Club, Library \& Cookery area. As it is blue it will be called the Blue Room from now on! If you use the clubs, then please ring the gate bell as last term and a member of staff will admit you and then go via the conservatory, up the stairs to 'The Blue Room'.
The playgroup are temporarily situated in part of the school hall. This will be their home until the end of the project when they will move to their permanent home which will be the current Reception Class. The Reception Class will move to the next door mobile so they still have their lovely outside area. Miss Hancox with Years 1 and 2 will move to the new class in the main building - with new toilets too!
Over the next few weeks the catering kitchen off the hall will be revamped \& built.
School life will go on as before with children enjoying their hot dinners in the hall. Children eating sandwiches will go in the hall if there is room or in a classroom. This will only be for a maximum of 10 weeks.
