Dear Parents,

DATA results are through from the DfE and this year they report them in quintiles which tells schools where about they are in comparison to other schools in the county for progress - governors wanted us to share our wonderful successes:

KEMBLE - were in the top 15% of all schools in the country for reading and in the top 30% for maths. Our higher attainers were in the top 18% for reading and maths!

**SIDDINGTON** - Siddington children were in the top 2% of the country for writing progress!

PARENT / HEAD CHAT - Kemble - as promised at the last meeting, the day / time was moved so that people who work could attend. We caught up with issues that were raised last time:

- Club behaviour this seems to have improved now and we are still working on 'respecting all adults and children' in our assemblies

#### NEXT STEPS FOR SCHOOL

School is working towards the Gloucestershire Healthy Living and Learning (GHLL) award - the most recent piece of work being the well being policy - which was agreed by parents as a good policy. Parents were reassured to hear that we can access mental health support when needed through referral to Children & Young Persons Service (CYPS) and that we currently have a teaching partner being trainied as an Emotional



Literacy Support Advisor (ELSA). We will be designating a room for children to access support when they need it and to run mental health & wellbeing courses.

SCHOOL UNIFORM REMINDER - We like to keep a strict uniform policy at school so that all children can feel a part of the school and the clothing is practical. No one has to worry about fashion or not having the latest trends. With this in mind, I would like to ask all parents to remind children that hoodies, even the school logo ones are for PE and tournaments only.
